

Reignited Attentat on RIOT-tour in winter 2021 – 2022



A fueled up Attentat goes on tour after almost two years of quarantine. Their latest album “Punkhjärta” and fresh single “Jag älskar inte dig något mer”, are packed up for the ride, but the band will of course have epic punk-classics such as “Ge fan i mej”, “Unga och många” and “Maktlös” on the set list.

The current version of the band is an effective rock n’ roll machine (think D A D on steroids with a “pop-feel” to it). In March 2020 Jönsson and his cronies had just started a 17-gig long tour with the first stop in Lysekil, for a protest against Premraff. Then suddenly Sweden closed down, and all the energy the band had pumped up was redirected towards songwriting and studio sessions.

At this crucial moment Attentat found a new path. The band met producer Per Stålberg, best known as singer in Division of Laura Lee, but also a successful producer and owner of Welfare Sounds & Records. Influenced by Stålbergs massive sound and new, young bass-player Linus “Siken” Sikström’s energy, Attentat found a darker, more dangerous sound. We’re talking punk rock as it should be – fast, furious and thrusting, the element of pop slightly reduced but, still there – it is Attentat after all!

Attentat were pioneers and figureheads in the first Swedish punk-era, alongside bands such as KSMB and Ebba Grön. On the RIOT-tour (Rock I OrosTider), Attentat wants to use the power of music power to inject hope and joy into a nation torn apart by economic divides, intolerance and the dismantling of welfare systems.
